

EPA CLEAN SCHOOL BUS 2023 GRANT PROGRAM

This is a competitve grant-based program that has certain criteria where a school district or third-party applicants will be able to earn points based on their scope of work and prioritzation. There are \$400M dollars available through this round of funding. This program is separated into two different sub programs:

School District Sub Program

Must request a **minimum of 15** school buses and request a **maximum of 50** school buses.

Third Party Sub Program

Must request a **minimum of 25** school buses and a **maximum of 100** school buses. Third party applicants must support at least four different school districts on the application.

FUNDING AMOUNTS

For prioritized districts, they can receive up to \$395,000 per bus for bus and charging infrastructure.

For non-prioritized districts, they can receive up to \$250,000 per bus for bus and charging infrastructure.

NUMBER AND AMOUNT OF AWARDS

EPA anticipates awarding a total of approximately 25-50 cooperative agreement(s).

*Region 5, Total Anticipated Funding: \$51,600,400.

*Michigan is in region 5 along with Ohio, Illinois, Indiana, Wisconsin, and Minnesota.

2010 or older must be scrapped.

2011 or newer can be scrapped, sold, or donated.
